

JOB DESCRIPTION

Technician

General:

The extraction technician will be assisting in the analyses of gas, liquid and soil samples for various constituents, mostly those identified as hazardous wastes or toxic substances. The position requires strict adherence to printed method practices and use of appropriate personal protection equipment.

The position involves the assignment of laboratory identifiers to client samples, implementation of chain-of-custody practices, accurate weighings, glassware sanitation, clear labeling, work documentation, as well as data input in a fast paced environment. All of this work is directed by either a chemist, project manager, or assigned by the extractions supervisor.

Extraction technician involves a significant amount of standing, hand manipulations, occasional bending and lifting of items generally weighing less than 50 lbs, but occasional lifting of heavier items in a fast paced environment.

Job Elements:

The technician will work in the laboratory to perform analyses in support of Friedman and Bruya's client activities. Analyses are to be performed in accordance with the specifications of the project plan established by the Project Leader and written practices detailed in our SOPs (standard operating practices).

The technician is to notify their direct supervisor, chemist or project manager of any problems that are encountered.

All duties of the technician are to be performed within the guidelines of the Friedman & Bruya, Inc. Policy Manual.

Job Requirements:

- At least 18 years old
- Strict attention to detail
- Work in fast paced environment
